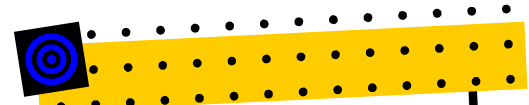

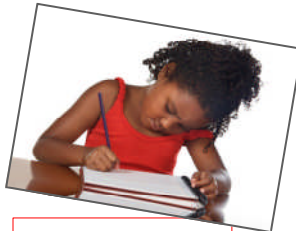

Academics

Grades 2–8

Morning Classes

Improving Reading/Writing Skills

(Grades 2 – 3) (Grades 4 – 5)

This class features small group instruction according to student's needs. Basic reading skills with an emphasis on phonics, vocabulary, and comprehension, will be stressed.

(Grades 6 – 8) Improvement of reading and writing skills for the junior and senior high school student will be the goal of this class. Grades are separated based upon test results.

Improving Math Skills

(Grades 2 – 3) (Grades 4 – 5)

This class features small group instruction. Topics will include: basic mathematics, computation skills, and problem-solving.

(Grades 6–8) This class will review basic operations. Topics include sequential mathematics, algebra, geometry, problem solving, statistics and logic.

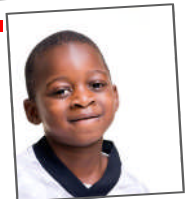
Piano

(Grades 2 – 8) Young people will be exposed to the piano keyboard, theory, sight-reading, techniques of rhythm and correct fingering. Students do not have to own a piano. Upon completion, students will be able to play selections. **Students must supply their own headphones.**

Vocals

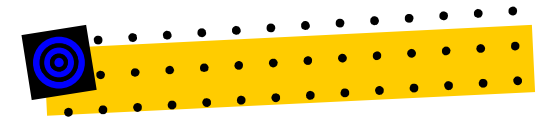
Students will be taught group numbers, learn harmonies and perform together as a group.
